### ATTENTION DRIVERS: Disabled Parking Placards

ECHHO has been issued handicapped parking placards that can be hung from the rear-view mirror. The placards will allow drivers to park in handicapped parking spots when transporting people who qualify for it. You may check out a placard at the office prior to your trip and return it when you come back.

Following is a synopsis of the requirements to be allowed to use handicapped parking:

- cannot walk 200 feet without stopping to rest;
- is severely limited in ability to walk due to arthritic, neurological or other orthopedic condition;
- cannot walk without use of or assistance from brace, cane, another person, prosthetic device, wheelchair;
- uses portable oxygen;
- legally blind with limited mobility;
- restricted by lung disease and/or cardiovascular disease or cardiac condition.

Office staff will coordinate with drivers when rides are scheduled for handicapped clients.
